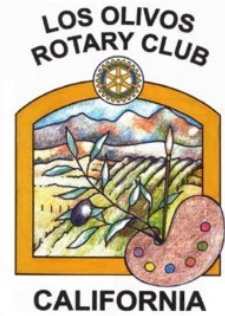

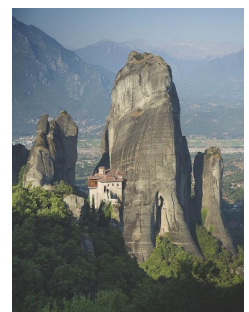

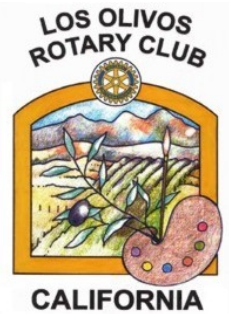
This cutting edge day will provide you the tools and connections for starting new projects and partnerships both in your own backyard and globally."
